

# Infertility treatment FAQs

## (Gifu Prefectural Child Rearing Support Division)

**Q1** I would like to know more about fertility treatment subsidization in Gifu Prefecture.

**A1**

Subsidies for micro insemination and in vitro fertilization of up to 100,000 yen are covered by insurance.

One of the requirements is that at the time of application, either the husband or wife, or both, must be residing in Gifu Prefecture.

**Q2** What are the required documents for applying?

**A2**

- ① Gifu Prefecture Specific Infertility Treatment Subsidy Application Form and Claim Form (Can be downloaded from the Gifu Prefectural Government website).
- ② Gifu Prefecture Specific Infertility Treatment Subsidy Certificate of Medical Examination (Can be downloaded from the Gifu Prefectural Government website).
- ③ Original copy of receipt(s) issued by medical institutions who provided the specific infertility treatment(s).
- ④ Certificate of residence dated within 3 months of the date of application.

**Q3** How do I apply?

**A3**

In the same fiscal year (April to April) that the treatment was completed, send the required documents by special/ recorded delivery to the address below.

※On the envelope make sure to write “Gifu Kencho (Application for Specific Infertility Treatment Subsidy). In Japanese this is “岐阜県庁 (特定不妊治療費助成事業補助金交付申請)”.

(Yuubinkyoku-dome refers to poste restante/ general delivery.)
