I arrived in Japan before the change to the new residency management system (before July 9th, 2012). How can I receive my resident card?

Depending on your status of residence and your age, the date by which you must exchange your alien registration card for a resident card differs.

If you would like to get your card at your own request you can do so at the Gifu Regional Immigration Office.

You will need to submit a photo 40 mm high and 30 mm wide.

Take JR bus City loop line (市内ループ) from stand 11 on the north side of JR station. Get off at Shimin Kaikan ・ Saibansho Mae (市民会館・裁判所前).
