

Watch out for Fire Ants.

Dangerous and venomous ants, not present in the past, have been found in Japan.

If you find them, **do not ever touch them!**



Hiari *FIRE ANT*

Size: 2.5mm~6.0mm

Characteristics:

- Red-brown body color.
- Pedicel with two nodes.
- Venom-injecting sting in the tail.

When stung, you may feel severe pain. Conditions may be even worse and more severe if allergy symptoms are developed.

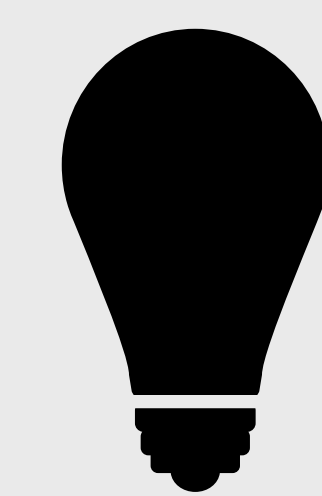

A large ant-hill constructed by fire ants.

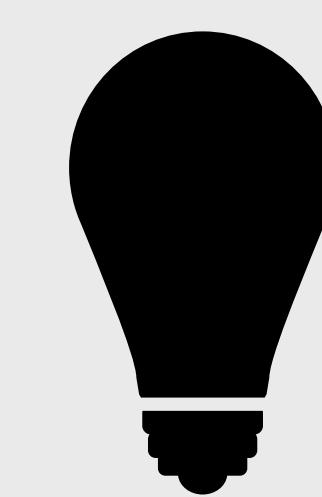


Fire ants on a leaf.

Typical ants in Japan do not construct large ant-hills. If you find a large ant-hill, report it immediately without touching it.

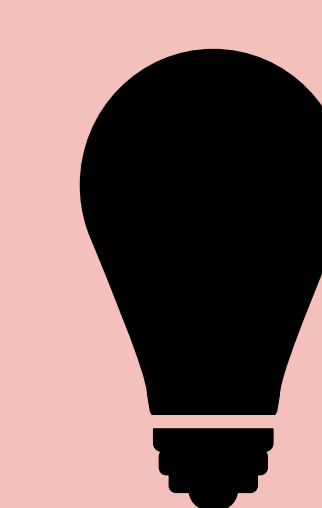


Are they fire ants?

If you find ants that look like fire ants, do not exterminate them by yourself, but report it to the local environment offices or prefectural environment bureaus near you.

If you are stung and feel any abnormality, **go to a hospital nearby right away.**

Inform a doctor that you have been stung by ants and receive appropriate treatment.

Symptoms caused by the fire ant venom may differ widely depending on individuals.
